and put their trust in the LORD.

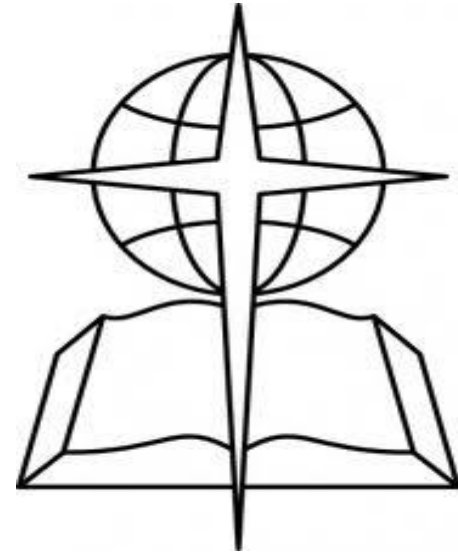
**Blessed is the man who makes
